**ORDER**

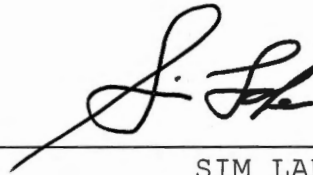

3. The Order for Conference and Disclosure of Interested Parties (Docket Entry No. 6) is **VACATED**.
