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Company leadership is pressuring workers to return to the office in hopes of improved productivity. **Yet, most employees say hybrid / remote working makes them more productive.**

48% of office workers report experiencing pressure to return to the office in the last 12 months.

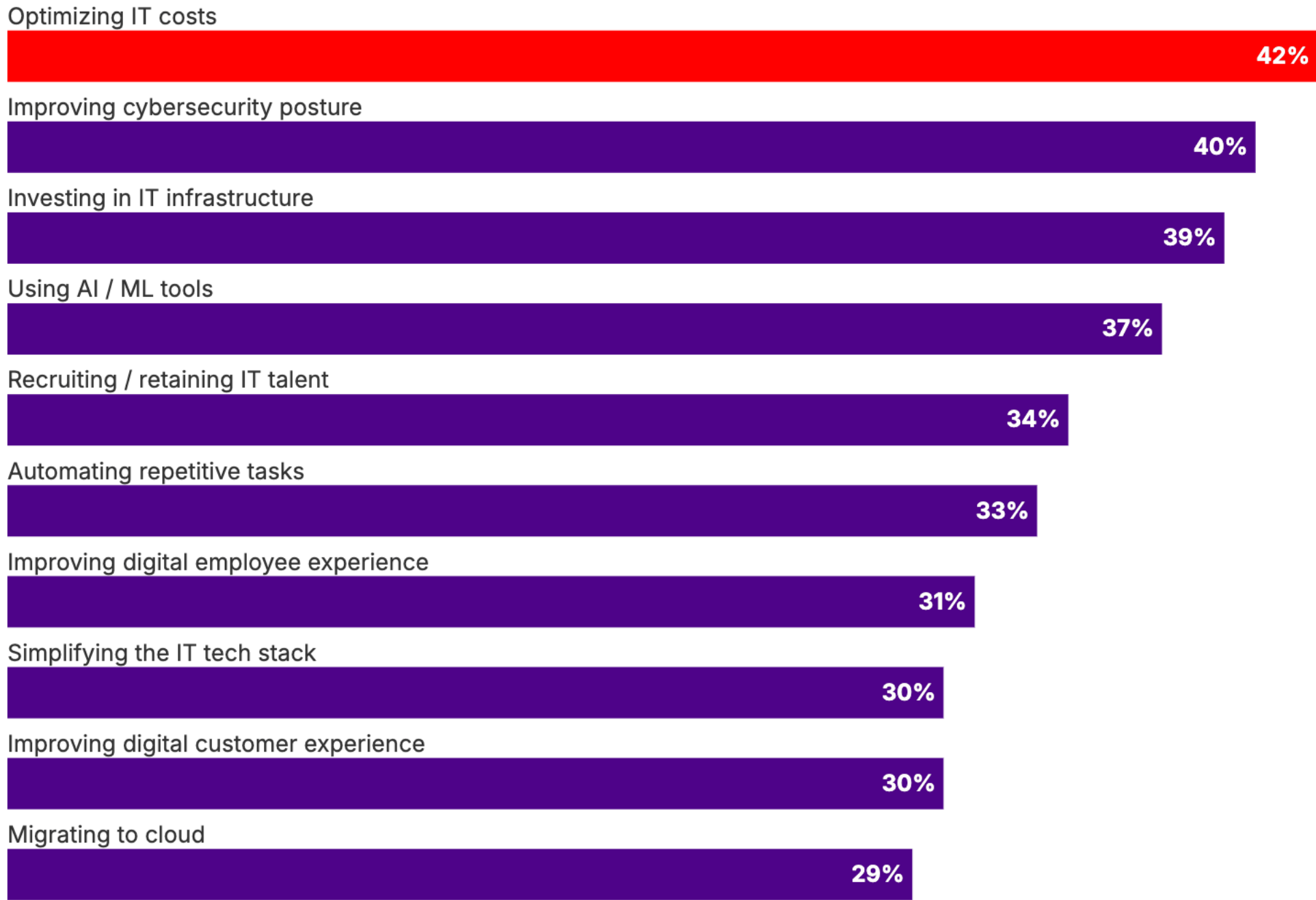

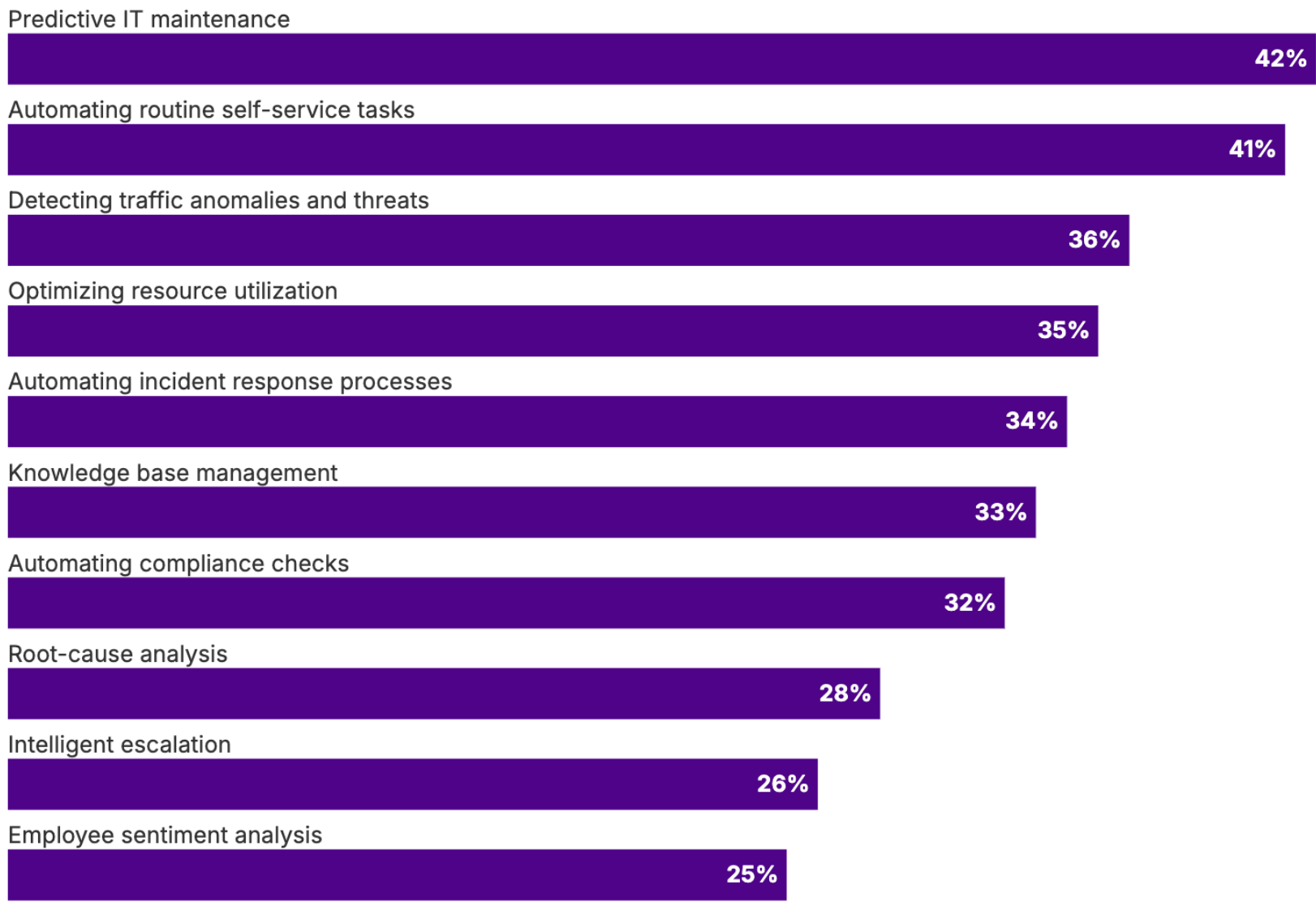

1. How do we define and measure efficiency and productivity for employees both inside and outside of the office?
2. What changes do we need to make to our tech infrastructure to improve digital experiences and collaboration for employees working virtually?
3. How can IT leaders and other executive leadership ensure better visibility and alignment on IT investments?
4. How are we prioritizing how the organization balances innovation and technology investments with managing our levels of tech debt?
5. What is our plan for equipping employees with the skills they need to leverage AI investments in a way that supports overall business objectives?



About the research

Ivanti surveyed over 6,000 office workers and 1,200 IT and cybersecurity professionals in February 2025 to explore the challenges and opportunities employers face as they empower employees to work flexibly and remotely. The research also explores how companies can deploy technology to safeguard productivity and maintain security while giving employees greater autonomy at work.

This study was administered by Ravn Research, and panelists were recruited by MSI Advanced Customer Insights. Survey results are unweighted. Further details by country are available by request.

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
